I=U BROOKLYN CELEBRATES MUSICAL IMPROVISATION IN BUSHWICK THIS MAY

London-based i=u takes over Brooklyn Fire Proof May 9th + 10th bringing its unique concert experience of spontaneous musical creation and audience interaction

April 9th, 2014 - Following their successful <u>2013 festival in London</u>, the i=u organization has set its sights on the artistic community of Brooklyn and the greater New York region. Welcoming over 900 visitors to Yinka Shonibare's Guest Projects last year, festival goers were able to experience an unprecedented range of musical genres, presented by a wide-ranging group of musicians, visual artists, tap dancers and more, all connected by their passion for improvisation and engaging audience interaction.

Now, i=u Brooklyn will serve as a platform for continuing these musical ideals across the pond. On May 9th, i=u will celebrate their partnership with <u>Gabriel Prokofiev</u>'s London-based <u>Nonclassical</u> label, curating the night with a special focus on reinvention in the classical genre and explorations of the experimental, new music and avant-garde traditions. May 10 will move towards influences from the rock, folk, jazz and world music scenes, featuring audience-engaging performances from legendary American composer <u>David Amram</u> and English folk/electro/beatboxer Cosmo Sheldrake.

BOBBY MITCHELL:

The Young New Yorkers' Chorus and Artistic Director Michael Kerschner will present a program incorporating looped reflections from the audience layered over a choral performance of American folk hymns. The program will begin with an adaptation of Edwin London's *Bach (again)*, an influential choral work that fuses a Bach chorale with movement and aleatoric techniques. http://www.ynyc.org/

DAVID AMRAM:

Legendary American composer David Amram will lead a group of improvisers in a spontaneously-formed work which he calls, "Making an Omelette with Miles Davis," taking influence from his actual culinary creation made of the random ingredients he happened to have in his fridge when he met Miles in the 1950s. www.davidamram.com

Through conversation and musical eruption, MDF will perform an ever evolving piece that challenges the audience to reflect in the immediate moment and converse not only with one another, but open a line of communication with the individual self through prompted reflection... www.michaeldylanferrara.com

In his first major US appearance, UK-based Cosmo Sheldrake promises to bring the audience into an overwhelming spin of folk and world music influenced loops, creating a large-scale participatory sonic environment. VINCENT LEGGIO:

Method actor Vincent Leggio will perform "The tortured artist behind Chester Binghampton" an improvised story of the unfortunate artist using suggestions from the audience. He will be accompanied by a DJ, adding musical cues and transitions, similarly to the way music was used in Commedia dell'arte.

GRUMBY:

Brooklyn-based duo Grumby will close the evening with an immaculate DJ set, shredding through layers of intricate physics and sound. http://soundcloud.com/grumby
